Who are we:

We are a Regional Group set up under NSW Aboriginal Affairs OCHRE – Local Decision Making (LDM) strategy. We consist of Aboriginal people knowledgeable in the following areas: Health, Family and Well-Being, Education, Youth, Elders, Employment, Housing, Law and Justice, Transport, Local Government, Land Councils and Native Title.

What do we do:

- ◆ Advocate to state government on behalf of Aboriginal communities of the far North Coast region in relation to service delivery
- ◆ Undertake a leadership role and foster leadership initiatives particularly amongst our young people
- ◆ Contribute to policy development particularly in relation to NSW Government's Indigenous policies
- ◆ Distribute relevant information to Aboriginal people in the region particularly on service delivery
- ◆ Seek innovative and creative opportunities to benefit Aboriginal communities in the far North Coast
- ◆ Seek to empower Aboriginal people and communities through unity on a regional level

What we don't do:

- ◆ NCADA is not a funding body however we may be able to advise of appropriate funding bodies
- ◆ NCADA does not advocate for individuals – however we may be able to link you with organisations/groups that provide this service
- ◆ We don't have the ability to fix every problem every community faces. However, we will work to the best of our ability, to work with and support communities in an effort to improve the lives of Aboriginal people
